TREE PLANTING OR REMOVAL PERMIT

A tree planting or removal permit is required for planting, removal, or pruning of more than 20% of any tree within the public right-of-way. Work cannot be started until the permit is issued. This permit is subject to all of the rules and regulations pertaining to Chapter 5, Section 5.08 of the City of Chilton Municipal Code.

The following steps are required in order to plant or remove a tree within the public right-of-way:

1. Mark the area where the tree is to be planted or removed.
2. Call Diggers Hotline at 1-800-242-8511 to locate all underground and aboveground utilities.
3. Contact City Hall at 920-849-2451 to schedule an inspection of the marked area.
